

GENERAL RULES:

1. **We are a family friendly nudist campground**; we encourage families with children to visit. All visitors must register at the office upon arrival to CT and pay any fees due, such as Daily Grounds Fees and/ or overnight fees.
2. **CONDUCT:** We seek to maintain a safe, wholesome family atmosphere. Sexual advances in public will not be tolerated. Rude, obnoxious, drunken and/ or bad behaviors are not acceptable, and you will be asked to leave, no refunds of fees paid. If you are a member of CT, your membership will be terminated.
3. **CHILDREN CONDUCT:** You should never be alone with children that are not your own. If you inappropriately talk to, follow, or hang in the area of kids playing, you will be asked to leave.
4. **SWINGING:** Is not permitted. Soliciting people to swing or engage in any sexual activities is not allowed. Please report anyone that asks for you to participate in these activities.
5. **NUDITY:** CT is a Nudist Retreat, not clothing optional. We assume if you visit here, you have the desire to be nude when activity and weather permits. For females, at times it is necessary to wear bottoms.
6. **BODY JEWELRY/TATTOOS:** Body Jewelry with discretion. Tattoos may not be sexually suggestive. CT reserves the right to determine acceptability.
7. **TOWELS:** Sitting on one MANDATORY, please carry one.
8. **PHOTOGRAPHY:** Permission to photograph on the grounds must be obtained from the management. Please keep in mind that photography is a very sensitive area among nudists and extra caution is needed. Photography with cell phones or other devices are prohibited & such phones or devices will be confiscated. State & local laws provide strong civil and criminal penalties for the unauthorized clandestine photography and/or publication of nude persons in areas & under circumstances where they would reasonably expect privacy. It is our policy to report suspected violations to local law.
9. **ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** Cellphones, tablets, etc. are to only be used at your campsite, tent site, RV/ camper, cabin, or car, not in any of the public areas of CT. For 911 calls there is an emergency phone on the porch of the office.
10. **HOURS:** for visitors are Sun-Thurs 10 -6, Fri/Sat 10-8. Daily grounds fees do not extend past these closing times. If there is a scheduled evening event, the hours are extended to 11pm.
11. **OVERNIGHT GUEST:** must depart no later than 10:00 am the following day or pay daily grounds fees for an additional day. Cabins check in 1 pm check out 10 am. Each lodging site allows 2 adults per campsite. Any additional adults are charged \$10 per person per night.
12. **The quiet hours at CT are 11 pm to 8:00 AM Sunday through Thursday, 1am to 8am on Friday & Sat nights.** All children, including teens, must be on their campsite during quiet hours. All outside radios and TVs must be off. You are welcome to stay out at your campsite as long as you wish but please keep discussions and laughter to a level that won't disturb your neighbors. Don't forget it is your responsibility to keep control at your campsite, including your guests. **No loud music at any time, nothing should be heard past the perimeter of your campsite.**
13. **Cutting through campsites or flower gardens is prohibited!** Please be respectful to your neighbors and everyone at CT.
14. **Pool Hours:** Sunday – Thursday: 10 am to 9 pm Friday – Saturday: 10 am to 11 pm
The pool fence gates are locked outside of the open pool hours, please remove your belongings, and put away your chairs at the end of the day. Our lounge chairs are color coded as they stack better, please use care to put your chair back in the corresponding stack, pictures are attached to the fence for reference.
15. **FISHING:** Catch and Release with care no license required.

SAFETY GUIDELINES:

1. **Any injuries or accidents that take place on Cedar Trails Nudist Retreat, LLC, (also known as CT) Property must be reported immediately.** This includes, but is not limited to any automobile, golf cart or bicycle accident, fall, cut, abrasion, or dog bite (even on dogs or other pets) that requires medical attention. In addition, we are required to file a report and to interview all the parties involved.
2. **CAMERAS:** There are multiple security cameras and trail cameras located throughout CT, they are monitored by CT owners. They are used for everyone's protection, and to assist catching anyone breaking the rules. Any person caught adjusting, unplugging, or altering/ breaking any camera will be asked to leave immediately.
3. **WEATHER EMERGENCIES:** If the school bell rings by the office for an extended time, it is a severe weather emergency. We recommend you monitor weather applications that detail the local weather at CT, and you may seek shelter at the clubhouse or bath house.
4. **STRICT 5 MPH SPEED LIMIT.** Please brake for children, bicycles, pedestrians, and animals.
5. **BICYCLES:** riding is acceptable during daylight hours only. Bicycles are to be kept under control, giving the pedestrian the right of way. **Helmets** are strongly recommended for all children and adults.
6. **GOLF CARTS:** 16 years old & licensed drivers only. 5 MPH! Golf cart owners must sign the golf cart waiver if they bring a cart to use at CT. Only electric or gas golf carts are allowed to be driven by members or visitors at CT. Vehicles such as Go Kart, 4 wheelers and UTV's are not permitted.
7. **FIREWORKS:** are only permitted with written consent of CT Management.
8. **FIREARMS:** The use of firearms, bows & arrows, BB guns, pellet guns, paintball guns, air soft guns are only allowed to be shot on CT campground property with written approval from CT management. Guns maybe carried if you have a conceal carry permit that you have registered at the office.
9. **FIRES:** Fires are permitted only in the provided fire rings located throughout the campground or in a portable fire ring that you bring, provide for yourself to use.
10. **CHILDREN: Parents/ guardians are not to leave children under 18 alone or unsupervised at the campground.** Please ask your camping neighbor or other responsible adults to be in charge of your children during your absence. Please let us know at the office who is responsible for them in case of injury and how to reach you. You are responsible for your children at all times. Children under 12 must be supervised at ALL times including the pool, being at the pavilion or clubhouse. All children must be accompanied by an adult while using pool table or darts and after 10 pm.
11. **PETS: must be under control, leashed and cleaned up after.** Pets are not permitted in any of the campground buildings (including the clubhouse, bath house, & Pavilion). Pets are not allowed in the fenced in pool area. Be responsible in leaving your pets inside of your RV, tent or cabin. Pets should not be left alone outside. No one wants to listen to barking dogs, it is your responsibility to assist them in keeping quiet. CT management may request you and your dog to leave if our rules cannot be followed, any paid daily or overnight fees will not be refunded.
12. **ALCOHOL:** Alcoholic beverages are acceptable at CT for adults over 21, but please drink responsibly. Intoxication is prohibited! If drunkenness becomes a problem, you will be asked to remove yourself and your RV/ tent & your personal belongings from CT property without refund of any fees or membership. The owners reserve the right to say, "How much is too much" and intoxication will not be tolerated.
13. **ILLEGAL DRUGS:** are not permitted without proper medical card then maybe used by card holder at site only. No drug use in public areas, cabins, bath house, etc.
14. **GLASS CONTAINERS:** Not permitted in pool, only inside clubhouse and pavilion!
15. **SMOKING:** We try to accommodate both the smoker and the non-smoker. No smoking or vaping in the bathhouse or in the swimming pool. The grass area inside the pool fencing has a smoking side and a non-smoking side. Ash cans are provided. **NO SMOKING** on the hiking trails! Do not dispose of cigarette butts on the ground.
16. **NO SOLICITATION** on the grounds or in CT private Facebook groups.
