

Visitors to Cedar Trails

Cedar Trails is a family friendly nudist retreat.

Cedar Trails is **NOT** clothing optional or adult only.

We welcome all visitors (families with children, couples, or singles) that are nudists, and do not require a Cedar Trails Membership to visit. We are family friendly, so there are children here. There is no need to make a reservation or call to visit one day, just make plans, and drive out. A good suggestion for first timers is to visit during the week, if possible, as normally we have fewer visitors, it is less overwhelming. And a single day visit is a clever idea also, to make sure the nudist lifestyle is comfortable for you.

After you come through the open gate there is a parking lot behind the office (green building) on the left. After you park, please go to the office, register & pay the daily grounds fees.

We will give you a map and show you where things are located around the campground. We do not offer tours. You may get naked before or after you register, that is up to you.

We suggest you get undressed beside your vehicle and leave your clothes & phone inside your vehicle. Most visitors bring a small cooler or backpack/ bag to keep their valuables and keys in. **Remember no electronics (cell phone, tablet, e-reader, laptop, etc) are allowed in the public areas of the campground.** They can only be used at your campsite, cabin, RV/camper or vehicle.

#1 item you need to bring is a towel to sit on.

We would suggest bringing any food and drink you want for the day (remember no glass containers). Yes, you can bring alcoholic drinks, but remember moderation, being intoxicated is not allowed and you will be asked to leave if you cannot drink responsibly. Other helpful items are a hat, sunscreen, bug spray, hiking shoes for trails, and printed reading material. If the weather is cool, think about bringing a robe.

We provide lounge chairs in the pool area, but on a busy weekend, you may want to bring your own lounge chairs.

CONDUCT: We seek to maintain a safe, wholesome family atmosphere. Sexual advances or displays of affection in public will not be tolerated. Rude, obnoxious, drunken and/or bad behaviors are not acceptable, and you will be asked to leave, no refunds of fees paid. **CONDUCT AROUND**

CHILDREN: You should never be alone with children that are not your own. If you inappropriately talk to, follow, or hang around kids playing, you will be asked to leave.

SWINGING: Is not permitted. Soliciting people to swing or engage in any sexual activities is not allowed. Please report anyone that asks for you to participate in these activities.

Once at camp, you will notice we are in the country, not close to any stores or a populous area. There is no food delivery, truly little cell phone or internet service. It is peaceful & relaxing during the week, do not expect a crowd or events. You have 60 acres to explore on a hike, lounge by our heated pool, fish in our catch and release pond, play cornhole, frisbee golf or pétanque. Bring printed reading material (not electronic) and relax.

Daily grounds fees are paid to permit you to visit and enjoy our beautiful campground and enjoy the amenities. It is a daily fee, separate from any overnight fees if you choose to stay the night.

If you are looking to stay overnight, our reservation system will allow you to book your own cabin or RV/camper site.

Tent camping does not require a reservation, it is an open space with plenty of room.

We are open daily, no matter what the weather forecast is, between 10 am and 6 pm Sunday - Thursday. Friday & Saturday 10 am to 8 pm. There are no refunds if you choose to leave early or if you misbehave and are asked to leave.

Our summer season for 2025 is May 16-Sept 14th and we close for 1 week June 15-20th for a private event. Our events are usually held on a Saturday, as that can be our busiest day of the week, weather permitting. Our events are posted on our website and FB page to keep you updated.

We recommend bringing your own food and drinks. We will be offering food truck service on some Saturdays over the summer, check our schedule for updates. At our pavilion, we do offer some soft drinks, water and ice available anytime on a cash basis.

We are pet friendly, your dog needs to be on a leash and picked up after. You need to stay with your dog, they cannot be left alone, unless you have rented a cabin or brought a camper/RV and your dog can be left safely inside. Dogs should not be left alone in a tent. If you are visiting for a day, I don't recommend bringing your dog along, as they are not allowed in the pool area, pavilion or bathhouse area.
