

CEDAR TRAILS NUDIST RETREAT, LLC

TOP 11 QUESTIONS

1. What happens if I get an erection? Put a towel over it, go for a walk, take a cold shower, whatever it takes to calm yourself down. We like to maintain a non-sexual environment, which assists so this is not an issue. It is not acceptable and if you cannot control yourself; you will be asked to leave the campground.

2. Is Cedar Trails clothing optional? No, we are a nudist retreat, we assume you are visiting with the expectation to be nude, weather or sunburn permitting. If you are new to nudism, we give you a couple of hours to get comfortable. Yes of course, sunglasses, shoes and hats are permitted. We are clothing smart and realize that evenings are cool and some nighttime clothing, such as a robe is acceptable, lingerie & underwear is not acceptable.

3. Do you allow swingers or have swinging? No, we are a friendly family retreat and swinging is not permitted. No one should be approached asking for swinging. Remember, any sexual activities need to be behind closed doors.

4. Are singles or a married individual without my spouse allowed to visit? Yes, we allow any nudist, whether it is an unmarried single or a single individual that is married and your spouse is not a nudist. Please remember this is not a pickup joint, most nudists come to relax, enjoy nature, and meet other like-minded nudists, but not looking for a date.

5. What about gay visitors? As stated above, we allow any adult or family that is nudist to visit.

6. How old do I need to be? You must be 18 years old or older. If you are under 18 you need to be accompanied by a parent.

7. How many people will be around when I visit? And will there be someone I can talk to? It is impossible to answer how many visitors on any given day, it varies from day to day as we are very weather dependent. You should be prepared to entertain yourself and remember that there are no electronic devices allowed in public areas of Cedar Trails. There are plenty of activities such as relaxing by the pool, reading a book you bring, hiking the trails, fishing in our "Catch & Release" pond, playing cornhole etc.

8. What to bring:

Absolutely bring a towel to sit & lay on.

Any food and drinks for the day. There is no food delivery to the campground. We do have some sodas, water and ice for sale in the Pavilion for cash. Remember no glass containers.

I suggest having a small bag or backpack or cooler to put your keys & personal items and food & drink inside.

Bring a lounge chair, especially on the weekend or holiday if you are able, we have a limited supply, and they fill up quickly.

Sunscreen and bug spray are suggested. Hiking shoes or sandals if you are walking the trails.

Bring a good book or magazine as electronic devices are not allowed in public areas.

If the weather is cool, think about bringing a robe to wear.

Bring your own fishing pole and bait if you are looking to fish in our pond, no fishing license is required.

Above all, bring your smile and have fun!

9. What to expect when I arrive, its my first visit to a nudist resort? After you come through the open gate there is parking behind the office (green building) on the left. Next you need to register at the office and pay the daily grounds fees or other fees owed. We will give you a map and show you where things are located. Get naked before or after you register, that is up to you. Most bring a small cooler or backpack/ bag to keep their keys in.

After you have registered at the office, you are free to go about your day at Cedar Trails.

10. Membership, I want to join? We ask that you visit a few times before we talk about membership, to make sure we meet your expectations as a nudist resort and so we can meet you. One benefit of membership is that you can access the resort year-round. We do not require a membership to visit; you can visit as many times as you wish during our summer season.

11. Overnight Reservations: All overnight accommodation for a cabin or RV spot needs to be booked ahead of time online.
